Don Scearce, President, chaired the meeting. An update on the weed control of the lake was given by Jim Donahoe of Aquatic Weed Control. Approximately 42 acres of Eurasian Water Milfoil were treated in June.

Gary Hogle spoke on the improvements that have been made on the ravines on the North end of the lake. Another LARE grant has been applied for to address a problem at the Cable Run area of the lake. A seawall demonstration area may be built to show lake property owners the new type of natural seawalls the DNR is promoting.
